Oklahoma City bomber Timothy McVeigh is executed at the U.S. Penitentiary in Terre Haute, Indiana. The U.S. indicts 14 members of Saudi Hizballah, a militant Islamic group, in the 1996 bombing of a U.S. military housing complex in Dhahran, Saudi Arabia. An L.A. Superior Court orders Philip Morris to pay over \$3 billion to a smoker with cancer, the largest amount ever awarded in such a case. Former Yugoslav president Slobodan Milosevic is extradited to face a U.N. tribunal.

Economic inflation has exploded the prices of ordinary consumer goods. The dramatic effects of inflation are clearly illustrated in the following table of cost comparisons.


