In Washington, D.C., President Eisenhower meets with British Prime Minister Harold Macmillan to discuss global affairs. The U.S. Supreme Court prohibits passport denials to suspected communists. In Geneva, the Soviet Union authorizes the International Labor Organization to observe Soviet labor practices. Americans Deltev Bronk and Linus Pauling are elected to the Soviet Academy of Science. Former Hungarian Premier Imre Nagy is executed for not supporting the new pro-Soviet regime in Hungary. The Greek government discontinues military ties with Turkey.
