## Events of the Month

In Washington, D.C., President Eisenhower meets with British Prime Minister Harold Macmillan to discuss global affairs. The U. S. Supreme Court prohibits passport denials to suspected communists. In Geneva, the Soviet Union authorizes the International Labor Organization to observe Soviet labor practices. Americans Deltev Bronk and Linus Pauling are elected to the Soviet Academy of Science. Former Hungarian Premier Imre Nagy is executed for not supporting the new pro-Soviet regime in Hungary. The Greek government discontinues military ties with Turkey.

## Sports

The New York Yankees defeated the Milwaukee Braves in the seventh game to win the World Series. Basketball star Wilt Chamberlain signs with the Harlem Globetrotters. In football, the Baltimore Colts defeat the New York Giants 23-17 to win the NFL title. Jimmy Byran wins the Indy 500 with an average speed of 133.8 mph. The Brazilian soccer team defeats Sweden 5-2 to win the World Cup. A horse named Tim Tam wins the Kentucky Derby. Floyd Patterson knocks out Roy Harris in the 12th round in Los Angeles to remain heavyweight champion.

## Songs


